- Christian lifestyle & character that pursues Scriptural holiness (1 John 2:15-17; Hebrews 12:14)
- Willingness to submit to church leadership (Hebrews 13:17)
- Willingness to faithfully support the church with tithes & offerings (Malachi 3:10; 1 Corinthians 16:2)
- Use gifts in ministry to serve others (1 Corinthians 12:4-7)
